If you're a regular Habitat volunteer photographer, or have a personal interest in photography and videography long with an interest in Habitat, we invite you to gather your camera equipment and join us for a special workshop on Saturday, January 28, 2012.



We are blessed to have **award-winning, photojournalist and videographer, Doral Chenoweth of *The Columbus Dispatch*** to teach this workshop and share information, tips, and tricks for capturing stories through photos and videos.

Doral's photojournalism work has covered several social issues including the mortgage crisis, the stress of euthanizing cats on humane shelter workers, and the lack of affordable housing for low-income people. His photography has appeared in the *New York Times*, *The (London) Daily Mail*, *TIME* magazine, *USA Today*, and even one small photograph in *National Geographic*. Book credits include *America 24/7*, *Ohio 24/7*, *The*

*National Press Photographer's Association Best of Photojournalism*, and a book celebrating Habitat for Humanity International's 25th anniversary. He is also an adjunct instructor of photojournalism at Columbus State Community College. Doral and
