



Retail Associate – Full-time PLUS Benefits!

At Habitat for Humanity-Greater Columbus, our mission is to eliminate poverty housing and provide safe, decent affordable homes for hard-working, low-income families in Franklin County. The Greater Columbus ReStore is the retail arm of our organization. ReStore accepts donations of new and reusable home improvement materials and goods and sells these donated goods to the public at discount prices. Sales at the ReStore offset the administrative costs of the Habitat for Humanity-Greater Columbus Affiliate.

Due to growth, we are looking for 5 full-time Retail Associates to join our ReStore team. Retail Associates assist the Store Manager, Director, and other employees in the daily operations of the retail store and must possess a can-do attitude! During a typical work day, you will work in a fast-paced retail/warehouse environment loading and unloading items from vehicles, providing outstanding customer service, receiving and pricing items for sale, operating a cash register, organizing and cleaning the store, and training and supervising individual and group volunteers from diverse backgrounds and age groups. As you gain on-the-job experience, you will be trained to operate a 24-foot box truck and may assist with the pick up and delivery of items. These positions require being out in varying weather conditions for periods of time, frequently lifting up to 50 pounds and occasionally lifting up to 75 pounds, as well as being on your feet throughout the entire workday.

Retail Associate positions are full-time, with a starting rate of pay of \$10/hour, plus benefits!

Physical Requirements

- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds frequently and up to 75 pounds occasionally
- Must be able to stand, squat, bend, and climb in/out of truck frequently
- Must be able to work in varying weather conditions (such as, hot, cold, rain, snow)

Job Requirements

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Flexibility on work schedule, to include working weekends (Saturday or Sunday)
- Must be able to work at the Westerville Rd. or the Wilson Rd. store, as needed
- Valid driver's license, clean driving record
- Previous work experience, retail and/or construction/home improvement materials experience a plus
